Family Law Workshop

Some people do not have the desire or ability to hire a lawyer to represent them, but they may need legal help with a particular issue or portion of their case. The Dougherty County Superior Court, the Dougherty Circuit Bar Association, Georgia Legal Services and the Dougherty County Law Library have worked together to provide you with information that will better equip you to handle your own case.

This workshop will teach you about:

- Seven stages of a lawsuit
- Issues that come up in all family law cases
- Seven types of family law cases
(Divorce, legitimation, custody & visitation, child support, modification, contempt, family violence)
- Parental kidnapping
- Multi-state cases
- When you need a lawyer

Navigating through the legal system can be extremely difficult. Each case is different because each family's situation is different. Yet there are some basic rules that all cases must follow which this workshop will address.

No workshop can teach you everything you need to know about representing yourself in any legal action, but this workshop is designed to answer some of the basic questions you may have:

- What information do I need in order to file?
- Are there mandatory forms that I need?
- How do I schedule my case for a hearing?
- What are the operating procedures of the Court?

You can download forms for these family law cases free of charge from the Law Library's website. You can also download and print out forms at your local public library or the Law Library (copy charges apply). In addition, you can purchase forms at the Law Library. The cost for the forms are \$15.00 per packet.
